Projects

Whilst on the subject of Friends funding projects here is an update - you will remember that in our Spring Newsletter we reported that the Committee had decided to replace the Priory History Board, (situated adjacent to the turning bay in front of the Priory) which had deteriorated and become difficult to read. Whilst doing this we took the opportunity to change the format and text. Many thanks to Friends' member, John Wing, for his help with taking this project forward. We are pleased to report that this project has now been completed with the new board installed and looking good.

We are pleased to advise you that the John Fletcher portrait in the Fletchers Lea building now has a framed information text located at the side of the portrait.

Another project which has been under discussion at our Committee meetings is a replacement metal bench situated on the circular paved area on the back lawn. The style of bench has now been agreed

and this should be installed within the next few weeks. It will commemorate our 30th Anniversary in May 2025.

Some time ago in 2020, in fact, we decided to have some prints made of old Gosselin photos of the Priory for display. Since then, they have been framed and a suitable location has been found, they will soon be displayed on the first floor of the Priory.
